Big thanks go out to Debbie Hallmark for coordinating the worship and for all the Logos leaders who supported and encouraged the youth. Here are some of their projects:

- **RECYCLE** It's not too late to celebrate Earth Day by bringing recyclable plastic and glass bottles and aluminum cans to church. The Logos group is donating the proceeds to charity so it is a win-win situation.
- **PENNIES FOR PEACE** - Donations are still being taken to donate to this organization who is building schools in Afghanistan and Pakistan.
- **HYGIENE KITS** - The youth are making these kits for Haiti as well as for homeless children in San Diego. They need small bars of soap, toothbrushes, wash cloths and small towels and Band-Aids. Donations of cash are welcomed as well to fill in the kits and pay for shipping to Haiti.
